WORLD DAY OF PEACE

This year's World Day of Peace, celebrated on January 1, centers on "Migrants and refugees: men and women in search of peace". Pope Francis wants us to focus our attention to this world-wide phenomenon of people displaced for various reasons. He goes on to explain that the church's fosters a society open to people in need and ought to follow a path that seems to be the most Christian valued approach, based on four words and policies:
"Welcoming": calls for expanding legal pathways for entry and no longer pushing migrants and refugees into situation of violence and persecution.
"Protecting": has to do with our duty to recognizes and defend the inviolable dignity of those who flee dangers in search of asylum and security.
"Promoting": entails supporting the integral human development of displaced people, like access to education, work, housing and health.
"Integrating": means allowing migrants to participate fully in the life of society that welcomes them, as part of the process of mutual enrichment and fruitful cooperation.

DÍA MUNDIAL DE LA PAZ

El Día Mundial de la Paz de este año, celebrado el 1 de enero, se centra en "Migrantes y refugiados: hombres y mujeres en busca de la paz". El Papa Francisco quiere que nos enfoquemos en este fenómeno mundial de personas desplazadas por varias razones. Explica que la iglesia fomenta una sociedad abierta a las personas necesitadas y también la sociedad debe seguir un camino que es el enfoque más valorado por los cristianos, basado en cuatro palabras y políticas:
Acoger! esta acción nos llama a abrir las vías legales para la entrada para no forzar a los migrantes y refugiados a una situación de violencia y persecución.
Proteger! tiene que ver con nuestro deber de reconocer y defender la dignidad inviolable de aquellos que huyen de los peligros en busca de asilo y seguridad.
Promover! implica apoyar el desarrollo humano integral de las personas desplazadas, como el acceso a la educación, al trabajo, a la vivienda y a la salud.
Integración! significa permitir a los migrantes participar plenamente en la vida de la sociedad que los acoge, como parte del proceso de enriquecimiento mutuo y cooperación fructífera.
