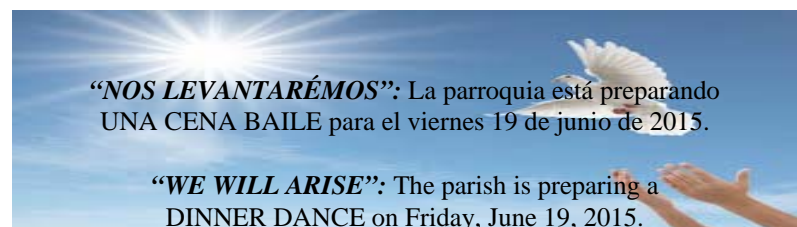

APPELLO ANNUALE DIOCESANO (ADA) 2015 (META \$42,694.⁰⁰)
Chiamati a fare il lavoro di Dio in Cristo, insieme

Per permetterci di raggiungere il nostro obiettivo annuale di Appello Diocesano, avremo un appello qui in chiesa in tutte le messe. Siamo molto grati a tutte le famiglie che hanno già promessa di Appello annuale di quest'anno. Siamo molto vicini a raggiungere il nostro obiettivo di \$42,694!!

Today we continue our reflection on children, the greatest blessing which God has bestowed on man and woman. I wish to focus our attention on the suffering which many children are experiencing. From the first moments of their lives, some are rejected, abandoned, and robbed of their infancy and future. There are those who say it is a mistake to bring these children into the world, due to their fragility, and the hunger and poverty they suffer. But children are never a mistake, and their sufferings are only reasons for us to love them even more. Every child who begs on the streets, who is denied an education or medical care, is a cry to God. Too often, these children become prey to criminals, who exploit them for commerce or violence. Even in wealthy countries, they suffer due to family crises and living conditions which are at times inhumane. In every case, their childhood is violated in body and soul. How did Jesus respond to the children and their parents who brought them to him: "Let the children come to me... for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven" (Mt 19:14). How beautiful the trust of these parents, and the response of Jesus! And there are many extraordinary parents who daily make sacrifices for their children. The Church offers her maternal care to all children and their families, and she brings them the blessing of Jesus. May we always care for our children, not counting the cost, so that they may never believe themselves to be mistakes, but always know their infinite worth?

Nelle catechesi sulla famiglia completiamo oggi la riflessione sui bambini, che sono il frutto più bello della benedizione che il Creatore ha dato all'uomo e alla donna. Abbiamo già parlato del grande dono che sono i bambini, oggi dobbiamo purtroppo parlare delle "storie di passione" che vivono molti di loro. Tanti bambini fin dall'inizio sono rifiutati, abbandonati, derubati della loro infanzia e del loro futuro. Qualcuno osa dire, quasi per giustificarsi, che è stato un errore farli venire al mondo. Questo è vergognoso! Non scarichiamo sui bambini le nostre colpe, per favore! I bambini non sono mai "un errore". La loro fame non è un errore, come non lo è la loro povertà, la loro fragilità, il loro abbandono – tanti bambini abbandonati per le strade; e non lo è neppure la loro ignoranza o la loro incapacità – tanti bambini che non sanno cosa è una scuola. Semmai, questi sono motivi per amarli di più, con maggiore generosità. Che ne facciamo delle solenni dichiarazioni dei diritti dell'uomo e dei diritti del bambino, se poi puniamo i bambini per gli errori degli adulti?
