What is Reconciliation?

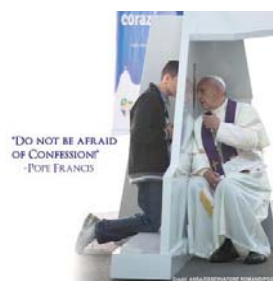
Reconciliation (also known as Confession or Penance) is a sacrament instituted by Jesus Christ in His love and mercy to offer us forgiveness of any sins we have committed against God, our neighbor or ourselves. Through this sacrament, we are healed, restored and free to be in right relationship again with our God, our family, our world, our Church. We prepare for it by opening ourselves up, by reflecting upon the areas in our lives bound by darkness, hurt, shame or guilt into which God so deeply desires to enlighten, heal, and free. In Reconciliation, involves four parts:

Contrition: knowing what my sin is and sincerely sorrow for having offended God. There can be no forgiveness if we do not have sorrow and a firm resolve to change with God's help.

Confession: confronting and having power over our sins in a profound way by calling them out aloud to God through the priest.

Penance: an important part of our healing is the "penance" the priest gives for us to do as a sign of our working to be in right relationship with God and others.

Absolution: the priest speaks the words aloud of what is really happening within you—the washing of your soul clean by the blood shed by the Lord Jesus Christ for you on the Cross.
